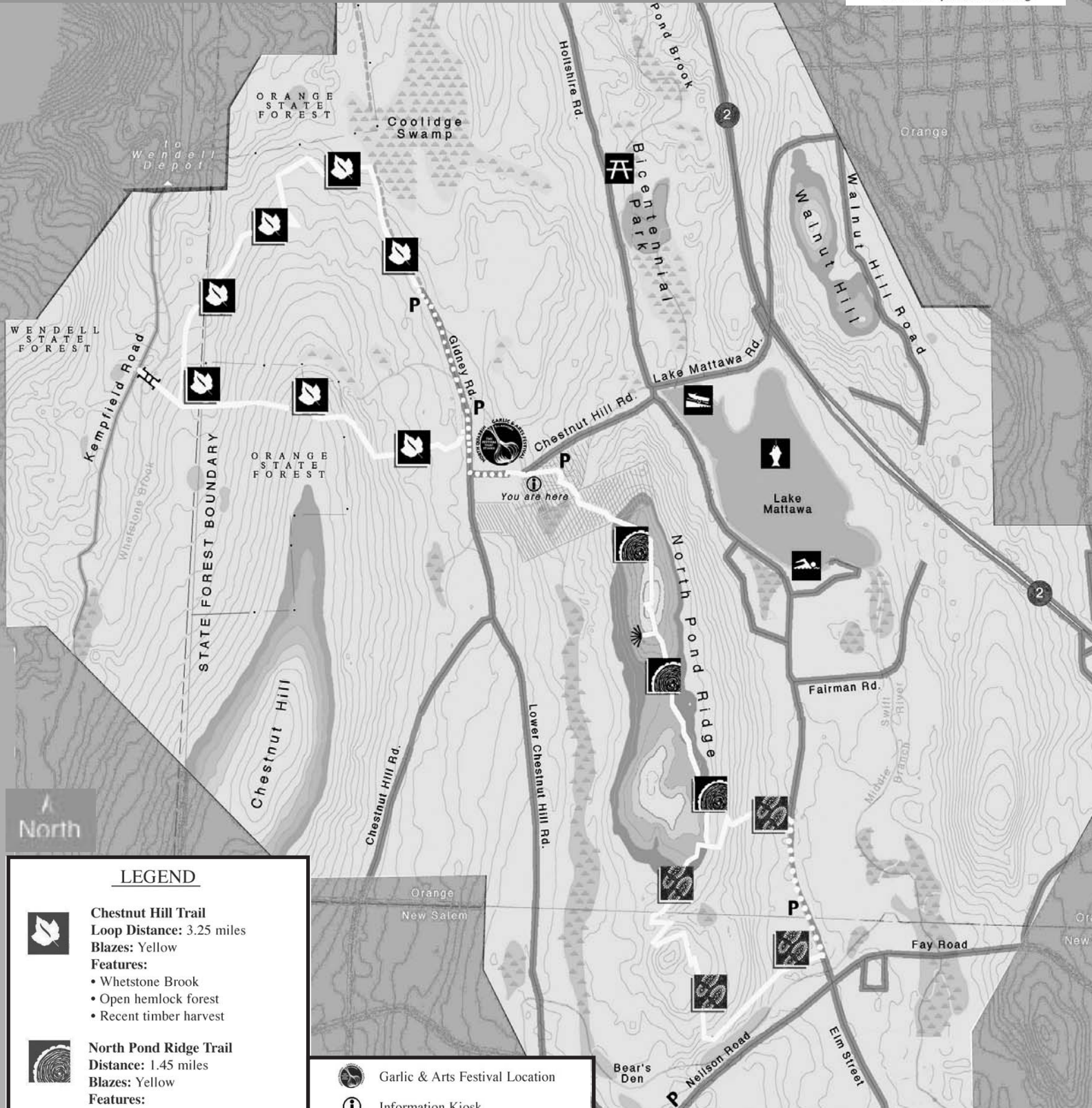


Chestnut Hill Trails

Features:

- Overlook to Chestnut Hill Ridge
- Trees bent by 1938 hurricane



Bullard Farm Loop
Distance: 2.05 miles
Blazes: White
Features:

- Swift River
- Link to North Pond Ridge Trail

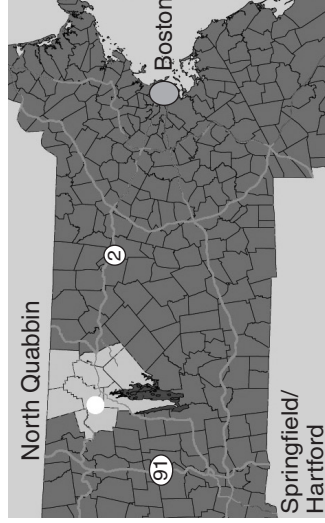


The Chestnut Hill Trail System:

Over 6 miles of blazed trails provide a glimpse of hemlock, pine, oak, and maple forests, fields, brooks and wetlands, and a view of Chestnut Hill Ridge -a landscape formed by glaciers, storms, and human use of the land.

A walk through a working forest is a walk through North Quabbin's past and present. The stumps and logging roads you see in this trail system are an integral part of our forest and farm economy. They complement other cultural features such as stone walls and trails, and natural features such as a beaver chewed log or a woodpecker hole.

Please respect the land and landowners by packing out what you pack in, abiding by signs, and avoiding impact to fragile areas, such as wetlands.

Providing opportunities for forestland owners to learn about topics ranging from forest thinning to timber taxes, from chainsaw safety to sawmill operation.



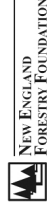
Locally made wood products. Over 50 wood products businesses ranging from sawmills to custom furniture makers are involved in our network to share information and collectively market local products.
